

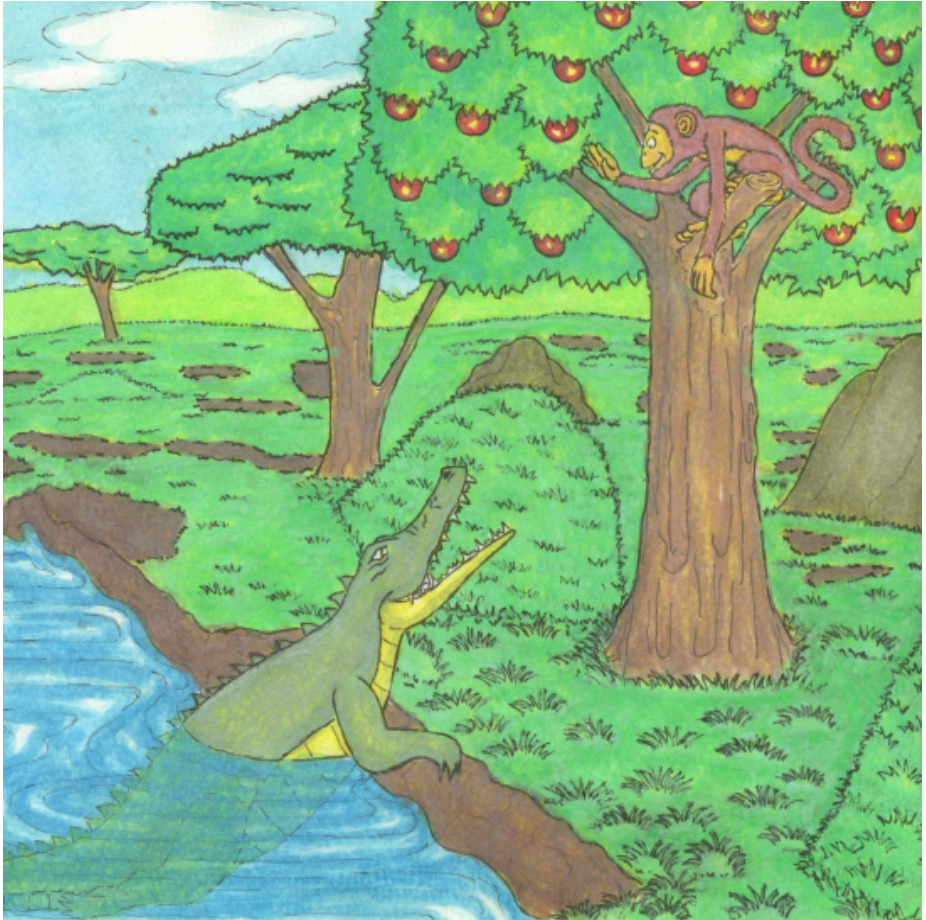


# Ngwenya naMfene bebabangani
