



Bophelo lešokeng la diphoofolo

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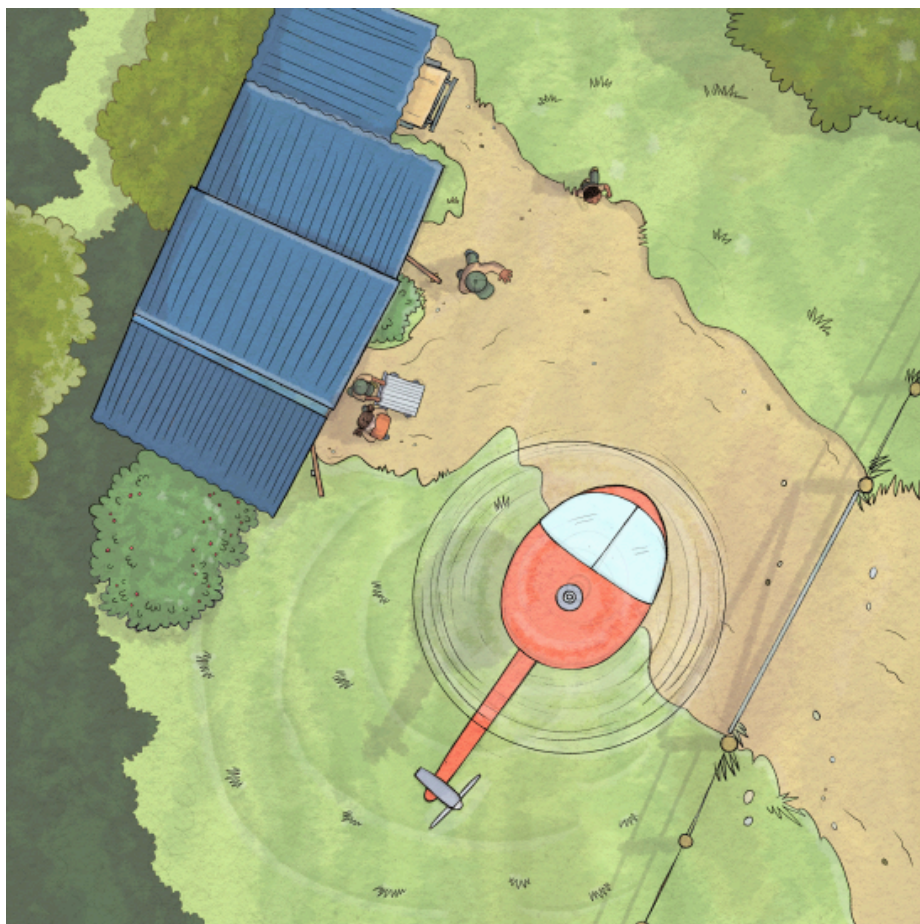
E be e le mesong lešokeng la diphoofolo, mohlokamedi wa lešoka Henry o be a ipshina ka teye ya gagwe.

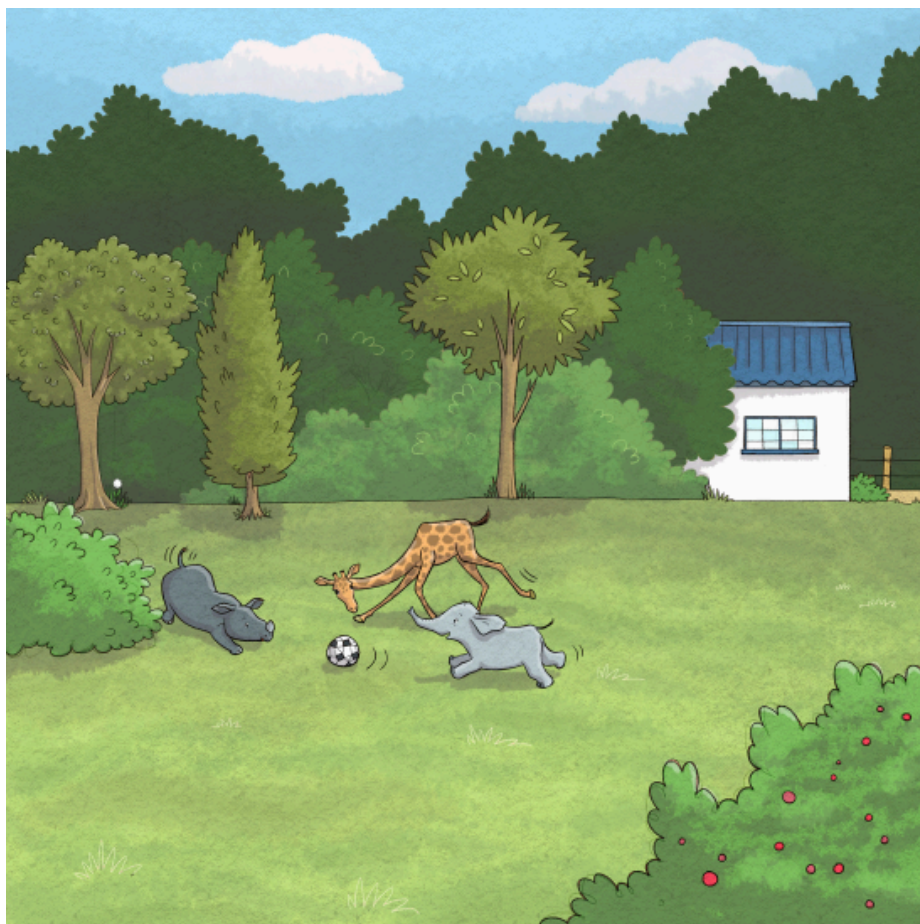
