“Zibizwa ngokuthiwa yini?” kubuza uSizwe aqale ngaphakathi kwebhodlelo.

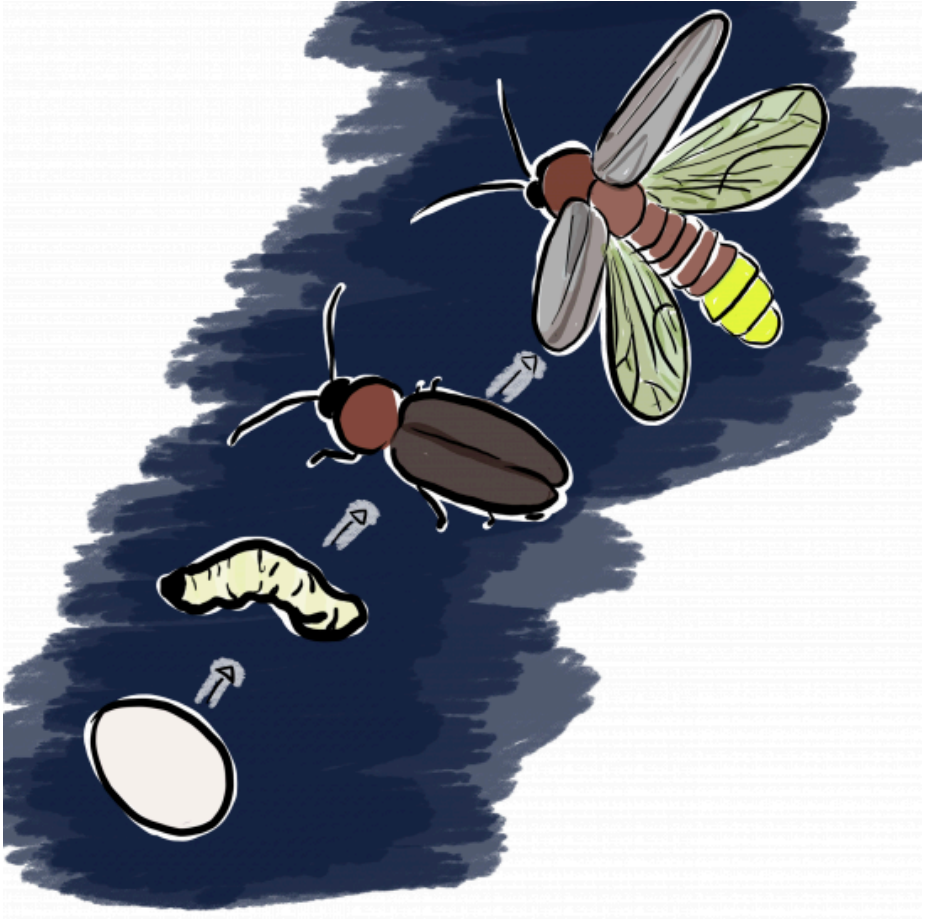
“Ziwenza njani umkhanyo loya?” kubuza uTito.

“Umkhanyo ubuya emzimbeni wenunwana,” kutjho yena.

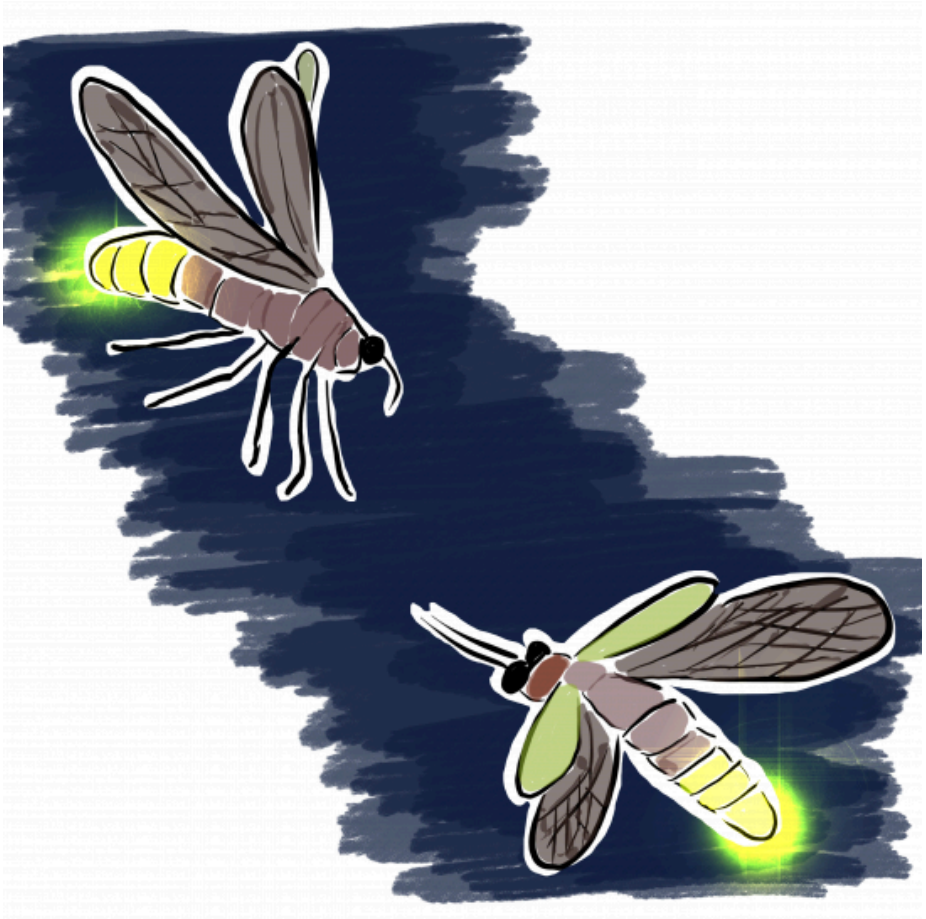
“Ngifunde ngeempukani zomkhanyo esikolweni!” utjho araga.
