Sihle thought, "They look so happy, sharing and chatting."



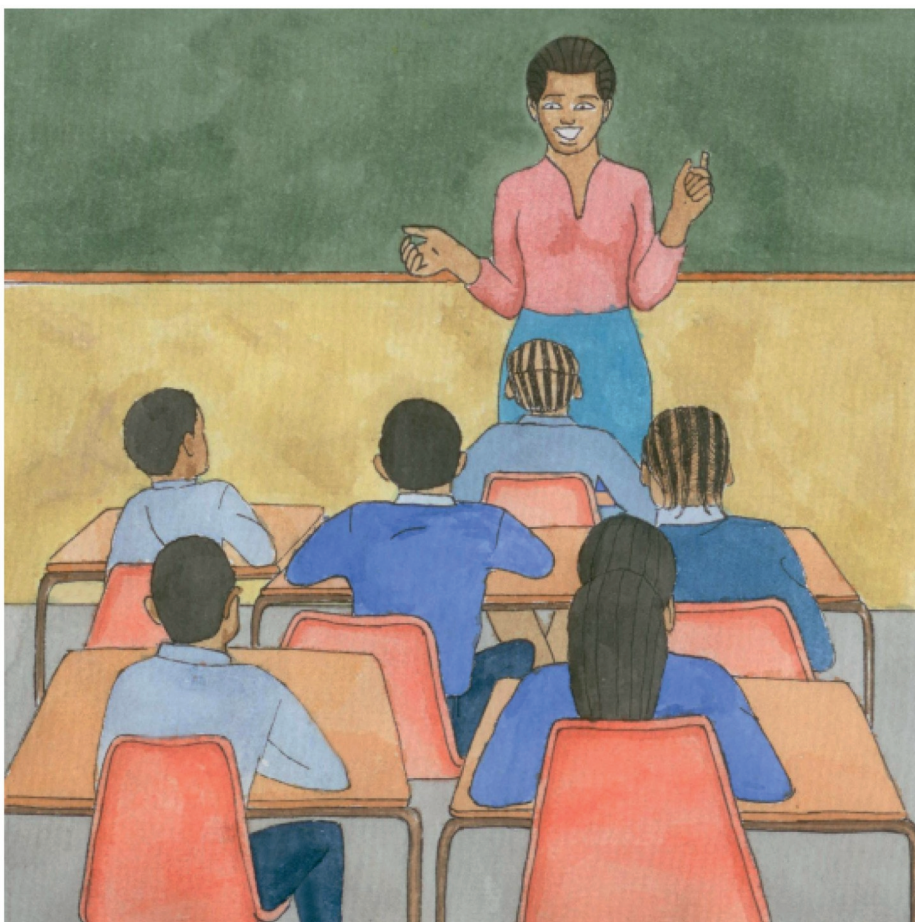
When Sihle went over but the children would not talk to her. She went to eat her lunch alone, again.
